Pushor Mitchell LLP Gold Medal Leadership Prize

Deadline: Friday, April 26, 2024, 4 p.m. PST

A \$10,000 prize is offered by Pushor Mitchell LLP to a graduating student in the Irving K. Barber Faculty of Science or Irving K. Barber Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences at The University of British Columbia Okanagan. In addition to academic achievement in the student's final 48 credits, candidates for the award must demonstrate leadership in one or more of the following areas: community service or volunteerism, cross-cultural relations, promotion of diversity, intellectual pursuits, and artistic or athletic endeavours. The prize is awarded on the recommendation of the Faculty.

We are looking for an outstanding graduating student who has demonstrated academic excellence and leadership qualities. Consider the award description above as you complete your application.

Application Process:

Step 1: Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria:

- You are graduating this current academic year with a Bachelor of Arts from the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences.
Note: applicants in the Faculty of Science should use the application found [here](#).
- You meet the minimum [Senate Regulations Governing University Awards](#).
- You demonstrate an ability to lead (directly or by example) in at least one of the following: community service or volunteerism, cross-cultural relations, promotion of diversity, intellectual pursuits, and artistic or athletic endeavours.

Step 2: Save the PDF form to your computer and open it using Adobe Acrobat Reader.

- PC users: Adobe Acrobat (*please do not use Microsoft Edge*)
- Mac users: Preview

Step 3: Forward the Reference Form to two referees to complete and submit confidentially.

- Referees should be able to attest to your leadership qualities and verify your involvement in the leadership role you describe in your personal statement.
- Each referee must submit the Reference Form directly to ikbawardsandevents.ubco@ubc.ca

Step 4: Complete and save the application. Submit to ikbawardsandevents.ubco@ubc.ca.

Note: Joint applications will not be considered.

The application and two reference forms must be submitted by **Friday, April 26, 2024, 4 p.m.** to be considered.
